Palm Sunday

Jesus triumphant entry into Jerusalem

Jesus had just raised Lazarus from the dead-

The grave clothes had been untied and Lazarus was risen - the resurrection power was in full

Manifestation

Luke

29 And it came to pass, when He drew near to [a]Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, *that* He sent two of His disciples, **30** saying, "Go into the village opposite *you*, where as you enter you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring *it here.* **31** And if anyone asks you, 'Why are you loosing *it*?' thus you shall say to him, 'Because the Lord has need of it.' "

32 So those who were sent went their way and found *it*just as He had said to them. 33 But as they were loosing the colt, the owners of it said to them, "Why are you loosing the colt?"
34 And they said, "The Lord has need of him." 35 Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. 36 And as He went, *many* spread their clothes on the road.

37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the **disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, 38** saying:

" 'Hosanna to the son of David (Matthew21:9) Blessed *is*the King who comes in the name of the Lord!'

Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

39 And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."40 But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

Jesus Weeps over Jerusalem

41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, **42** saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things *that make* for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.**43** For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, **44** and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Gen 49:10-11 and the obedience of the nations shall be His and He will tether his donkey to a vine his colt to the choicest branch

Zachariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."

Precise prophetic word 1500 years before Jesus

Zachariah 9:9 500 years before Jesus

Loose the donkey and the colt and say to the owner The Lord has need of it...

What is it that the Lord is asking you to give Him today

Jesus is triumphant - he is the messiah!

His kingdom is marching on! He has already overcome

He has already planned your redemption and victory before you messed up

But he is saying - you need to loose a few things so that Jesus can do in triumphant as the messiah and king of kings

The donkey - was a burden bearing animal - Jesus proclaimed His victory- proclaiming His purpose - that He would bear our burdens

He wasn't coming into Jerusalem for His sake - but for our sake

Jeremiah 23:37 "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones God's messengers! How often I have wanted to gather your children together as a hen protects her chicks beneath her wings, but you wouldn't let Me"

Symbols of victory

Palm leaves- symbol of victory -triumph, victory

Symbols of Messiah - as prophesied donkey

Adonijah - who was Absaloms younger brother declared himself as king and came in a huge parade with chariots, horses and messengers

Solomon's parade included him riding into Jerusalem on a donkey and the people shouting loudly

2 Sam 7 the son of David

Psalm 89 The son of David

- 1. What is God asking you to loose today! To give up or to give to step into partnership of Him becoming Lord and showing up as victorious in your life
- 2. Your praise in this season for what he HAS done for you is going to position you for victory and triumph in the current season shout louder than the lies of the enemy : disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, 'Blessed *is* the King who comes in the name of the Lord!'

Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

Save us now! hosanna to the son of David in the highest - blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord

And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. Matthew 21:9
