### Definition of boldness:

showing or requiring a fearless daring spirit (Merriam Webster) fearless before danger

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power (ability to act or produce an effect. possession of control, authority, or influence over others) and of love and of a sound mind.

# 1) BOLDNESS TOWARDS THE LORD

**Hebrews 10:19** Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus

Sing the son

-There is power, power..

Fame and fortune can't save us. No manager can get you a free pass into heaven. No religious leader can save you. There is only one Savior between heaven and earth and His name is Jesus.

**Ephesians 3:12** in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

**Hebrews 4:16** Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

We can boldly come to the Lord to speak to Him and spend time with Him. Imagine that. Imagine the most powerful person, the most powerful force in the Universe is God. He spoke creation into existence. How powerful is He.

# 2) BOLDNESS TO DISCIPLE PEOPLE

Then don't be shocked when your kids are acting up and your son Bill wants to be Gill and your daughter Claire wants to become Blair

**Proverbs 22:6** Train up a child in the way he should go (AS FOR ME AND MY HOUSE WE SHALL SERVE-not just believe in-BUT SERVE THE LORD), And when he is old, he will not depart from it.

It takes time to read them the Word. It takes time to talk to them and ask how school was, what dd you learn, what did they teach you.

Discipleship takes time yet its an ETERNAL investment that will reap everlasting blessings and fruit in people's lives.

### HONESTY IS THE BEST POLICY

### **Proverbs 27:6** Faithful *are* the wounds of a friend

People want to be politically correct. 'I don't want to offend anyone' That's not in the BIBLE. Preach the WORD.

Yet Jesus said 'You will know the TRUTH and the truth will set you free.

You will have an intimate knowledge of the truth. It will be revelation knowledge, not head knowledge. It will be revealed knowledge from God into your spirit.

Acts 28:30-31 Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.

- -Paul discipled people in groups-imagine been in Paul's connect group-lencourage you to commit to an Eternity Connect group
- -invest in your spiritual walk with the Lord-invest in discipling others as this is eternal

### THINK OF THE TIME WE SPEND

- -sleeping (7 hrs a day x7= 49hrs a week)
- -work (8 hrs a day x 7= 56 hrs a week)

- -eat 3 meals @ 15min/meal=45min/day= 5.25 hrs/week
- -Church 1.5hrs-Bible Study group 1.5 hrs
- -Daily Bible Study and prayer 30min
- =3.5 hrs a week

So we eating nearly twice as long as spending with the Lord and on spiritual things

12 times more sleeping than on kingdom things a week

### TAKE NOTE OF THIS

WHEN you disciple someone to serve the Lord, they in turn will disciple others and they will fulfill their destiny and make an impact.

**1 Chronicles 28:20** And David said to his son Solomon, "Be strong and of good courage, and do *it;* do not fear nor be dismayed, for the Lord God—my God—*will* be with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of the Lord.

David was encouraging his son Solomon to build the Temple

What has God called you to build?

Is it people? Is it a business? A political career? A school? Is it Eternity Church? Save the World Foundation? Your family, friends, work colleagues?

Jesus said in

**Acts 1:8** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

**1 Thessalonians 2:2** But even after we had suffered before and were spitefully treated at Philippi, as you know, we were bold in our God to speak to you the gospel of God in much conflict.

Ladies and gentleman **NO MATTER** what comes our way and no matter what we may go through we need to be bold in sharing the gospel. If we think of waiting for a perfect environment we will be waiting a really long time.

### THE BIBLE SAYS TODAY IS THE DAY OF SALVATION

**Ephesians 6:19-20** and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

**2 Corinthians 3:12** Therefore, since we have such hope, we use great boldness of speech

In **Acts 3** a crippled man gets healed at the temple when Peter prays for him. The crowd were astonished, and he then preached to them and about 5000 were saved. The Saducees were furious and beat them up and grabbed them and took them and locked them up. The next day they were taken and put in front of the Sanhedrin.

### Peter replied to them

Acts 4:8-21 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: If we this day are judged for a good deed done to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well, let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

But so that it spreads no further among the people, let us severely threaten them, that from now on they speak to no man in this name."

So they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard." So when they had further threatened them, they let them go,

The disciples responded to their threats BUT NOT like this:

Hey guys we better stop preaching because we are offending them We better stop preaching to them as this is getting violent and we can get hurt

They responded like this:

Acts 8:29-31 Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with <u>all boldness</u> they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

### **LET'S LOOK AT PAUL**

Acts 13:44-46 On the next Sabbath almost the whole city came together to hear the word of God. But when the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy; and contradicting and blaspheming, they opposed the things spoken by Paul. Then Paul and Barnabas grew bold and said, "It was necessary that the word of God should be spoken to you first; but

since you reject it, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, behold, we turn to the Gentiles.

**Acts 14:3** Therefore they Paul and Barnabas stayed there a long time, **speaking boldly** in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

**Acts 18:26** So he began **to speak boldly** in the synagogue. When Aquila and Priscilla heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.

**Acts 19:8** And he went into the synagogue and **spoke boldly** for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God.

# 5) POLITICAL BOLDNESS

"In the age-old contest between popularity and principle, only those willing to lose for their convictions are deserving of posterity's approval."

— Gerald R. Ford

"I have endured a great deal of ridicule without much malice; and have received a great deal of kindness, not quite free from ridicule. I am used to it."

— Abraham Lincoln November 2, 1863 in letter to James H. Hackett

"Courage is more exhilarating than fear and in the long run it is easier. We do not have to become heroes overnight. Just a step at a time, meeting each thing that comes up, seeing it is not as dreadful as it appeared, discovering we have the strength to stare it down.

When I speak about the political realm this is all levels of society. This is your school PTA, your work or business committees, local elections speaking up against ungodly practices.

Bad things happen when good people do nothing

Reinhard asked to address Parliament in one of Asia Pacific nations. He felt the Lord telling him to preach the gospel and do a call for salvation. He responded but Lord, what about the protocol. They Lord responded back

Don't worry about the protocol, GO FOR THE ALTAR CALL.

I was invited to Sun City which is the top hotel resort in South Africa and one of the best resorts in the world, to speak in a series of motivational messages to train the staff in guest relations. I told the General manager that I was an evangelist and not a motivational speaker. He said he knew, yet wanted me to come nonetheless.

It was 4 messages over 2 days at the Palace of the Lost City one of 4 hotels on the resort, which has been voted in the past top 2 hotels in the world. The cheapest room is about \$400 a night. The top one about \$3000 a night.

I asked the GM if I could share about Jesus and give people the opportunity to pray and receive Him. To my great delight, he said yes.

I was somewhat concerned that he may get fired as a result, yet he was one of the top luxury hotel managers in the world and had that authority to do it.

So over 2 days I shared inspirational messages yet spoke about Zacchaeus and Jesus and gave people the opportunity to receive Him.

About 200 staff received the Lord and we gave them each a pack of discipleship materials.

Here we look at Ester before the King, pleading for national deliverance

**Esther 4:13-14** Mordecai told them to reply to Esther, "Don't suppose that because you are in the palace, you will escape any more than the other Jewish people. Indeed, if you are silent at this time, relief and deliverance will come to the Jewish people from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. Who knows but that you were brought to the kingdom for a time like this?

**Vs 13** and then I'll go in to the king, even though it's against the law. And if I perish, I perish."

**Esher 5:1-3** On the third day, Esther put on her royal attire and stood in the inner courtyard of the palace in front of the king's quarters. The king was sitting on his royal throne in the throne room, opposite the entrance to the building. When the king saw Queen Esther standing in the courtyard, she won his favor, and the king extended to Esther the gold scepter that he was holding. Esther approached and touched the top of the scepter. The king asked her, "What do you want, Queen Esther? What is
